And when they heard this [the command from the angel], they entered the temple at daybreak and **began to teach**. (Acts 5:21)

And someone came and told them, “Look! The men whom you put in prison are standing in the temple and **teaching the people**.” (Acts 5:25)

And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease **teaching** and **preaching** Jesus as the Christ. (Acts 5:42)

how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and **teaching** you in public and from house to house, (Acts 20:20)

**proclaiming** the kingdom of God and **teaching** about the Lord Jesus Christ with all boldness and without hindrance. (Acts 28:31)

## AND THE ONE THING THEIR ENEMIES WANTED THEM TO STOP?

And when they could not find them, they dragged Jason and some of the brothers before the city authorities, shouting, “These men who have **turned the world upside down** have come here also, and Jason has received them, and they are all acting against the decrees of Caesar, **saying that there is another king, Jesus.**” (Acts 17:6-7)

and they set up false witnesses who said, “This man [Stephen] **never ceases to speak words** against this holy place and the law,” (Acts 6:13)

And while staying with them He ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, **but to wait** for the promise of the Father, which, He said, “You heard from Me; for John baptized with water, but **you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit** not many days from now.” (Acts 1:4-5)

But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will **send in My name**, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. (Jhn 14:26)

But before all this they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake. **This will be your opportunity to bear witness.** (Luke 21:12-13)

Paul spoke of this **powerful** responsibility to speak in 2 Corinthians 4:7-13
